

This contract is to be reviewed and agreed to by _____

("the client"). The following policies apply to Infinity Canine Dog Training LLC ("the company") and its employees ("the trainer").

Services

The services provided by this company for the client are dog training and providing education on dog training. This training may be for service dogs, comfort dogs, therapy dogs, or non-aggressive companion dogs. The company does not train dogs for police, military, protection, or search and rescue work. In addition, the company does not train or work with aggressive dogs. Aggressive dogs are classified as dogs who have seriously injured, or attempted to seriously injure, a person or another dog. The trainer will not provide unrelated services, such as veterinary advice, mental health counseling, or advice on a physical condition. The client should seek a qualified professional on these matters.

The company makes no guarantees of results from training, as there are many factors that can change the outcome of animal training.

Pricing:

The pricing of services is 90 USD for a 60 minute private session, and 50 USD for a 30 minute private session. An additional travel fee of 5 USD per mile (one direction) applies for locations outside a 20 mile radius from Shrewsbury, MA.

A notice of price changes will be given if or when they occur. Any and all price changes will not be applied to transaction made before the change. Refunds are to be granted solely at the discretion of the trainer. If a session is cancelled by the client, it can be rescheduled with no

additional fee IF the trainer is given 24+ hour's notice from the agreed upon time. Sessions canceled later than this must be paid for in full.

Liability waiver and release:

The Client acknowledges that dog training involves inherent risks, including but not limited to bites, scratches, property damage, or injury to persons or animals. The Company shall not be liable for any injuries, damages, losses, or harms to the Client, the Client's dog, property, or any third party arising from or related to the Services, whether due to negligence or otherwise. All veterinary/medical bills resulting from injuries to the dog or client sustained during the course of training will be solely the responsibility of the client.

Contact:

The client may contact the trainer using the provided email or phone number with matters related to the services provided. The trainer will respond within 1-2 business days unless unforeseen circumstances arise.

The client may only contact the trainer about matters pertaining to dogs or dog training. The trainer has the right to cease contact if the trainer feels that the client's contact is inappropriate or superfluous. The client shall not sell trainer's contact information without first obtaining consent from the trainer.

Nature of relationship:

The nature of the relationship between the trainer and the client is strictly professional. The trainer is not a mental health professional, physician, or veterinarian, and should not be treated as such. While some information about the client's disabilities and medical conditions may be shared with the trainer to aid in creating a successful training experience, the trainer should not be asked for advice on the treatment of these conditions.

Vaccination

The client must have their dog under the care of a licensed veterinarian. The company reserves the right to deny services due to a dog's insufficient vaccinations. Prior to training, the trainer reserves the right to ask for proof of vaccination status.

Any conduct deemed to violate this contract may result in the cessation of services and, in some cases, a banishment from receiving future services from the company.
